VIÊN THAO MEDIA LOOKING BACK ITS 26-YEAR EXPERIENCE

Viên Thao Media originally started in 1982 in Orange County, but officially operated in San Jose since 1984.

Viên Thao is the namesake of 2 principal characters in the collection of short stories titled "Muta Phố Núi" by Đỗ Vẫn Trọn and Lê Thao Chuyên. Viên Thao's initial logo was VT. Later, it became V symbolizing Việt.

Viên Thao Media enterprise started with Yêu Weekly Magazine and Yêu calendar publication. In the beginning, to publish Yêu Magazine, editorial staff was frequently moving on a van. Yêu magazine was dedicated to Poem, prose, love, and life articles that were warmly received by readers and advertisers whose services and businesses featured on Yêu's several pages. In 1986 the first edition of Vietnamese Yellow Pages – better known as Vietnamese Directory U.S.A. was published. It's the first Vietnamese Yellow Pages in Northern California.

In October 1989, VIÊN THAO TV started its broadcasting with energetic anchors, reporters, cameramen and editors. Current Viên Thao Media's TV Programs in The Bay Area include:

SAIGON TV broadcasting Monday to Friday from 8:00PM to 8:30PM on Channel 103 Digital Comcast

VIÊN THAO TV- SAN JOSE is the Vietnamese TV program that has been around the longest serving the Vietnamese expatriates, broadcasting Monday to Friday from 5:30PM to 6:30PM on Channel 28 KFTL.

WEEKEND TV broadcasting every Saturday from 5:30PM to 6:30PM on Channel 28 KFTL.

In 1992, **SAIGON RADIO** started its first broadcast on **Channel AM1500 KSJX** sending a strong vibration in the media circle, leading the way for other Vietnamese radio programs in Southern California to follow, and expanding to other states to the extent that now-a-days almost where ever exist a large Vietnamese community, there's a Vietnamese radio program. Now we have 2 Radio Programs:

SAIGON RADIO broadcasting Monday to Friday from **1:00PM to 4:00PM** draw a large and loyal audience due to their hot news, quality programs, popular anchors.

VT NEWS currently broadcasting Monday to Friday from 4:00PM to 7:00PM dedicated to providing news, weather & traffic information that's as hot and latest as any American radio. VT News Radio has reporters on most states filing live reports from any newsworthy parts of USA.

In addition to media operations, Vien Thao Media – for the last 25 years- offered many entertainment shows including movies and musical events featuring international actors, directors, and most famous Vietnamese artists living abroad.

Vien Thao Media's memorable events include: International Musical Events, Springs Festival, Youth's Musical Events, Vietnamese Traditional Musical Performances, Lobo Show, Hoi Ngo Trung Duong's Cruises.

In area of publication, YÊU WEEKLY MAGAZINE & CALENDAR PUBLICATION have published several books by respectable writers. From 1983, in collaboration with "Nhân Chứng Magazine" headed by well-acclaimed poet Du Tử Lê, Vien Thao Media has spearheaded the book Introduction & Review Events in the Bay Area (better known among the Vietnamese as "the valley of yellow flowers",) such as the books Introduction & Review Events for "Nỗi Niềm Mang Theo", "Mua Phố Núi", "Vietnamese Directory USA", "Guides for Newcomers"...

Vien Thao Media has received many commendations from presidents of USA, Senators & representatives, and local officials.

When mentioning Vien Thao Media, one can't help but think of momentous efforts by Mr. Đỗ Vẫn Trọn who's its founder and builder. He earned admiring mentions by Time Magazine, California Business Magazine as well as several other big newspapers. His name also was inducted to valuable pages of 2 international organizations ("International Who's Who of Intellectuals" and "International Biographical Center" in England), for prominence in initiative, literature and media. San Jose Mercury News named him "San Jose Mogul in a strange land". In June 1994, he was awarded president Kennedy's MPA & ASME Media Fellowship for Publisher & Editor at New York University. In November 2004, he won New California Media award (NCM Award) for essays and radio broadcaster. Annual NCM Awards are considered Pulitzer awards for ethnic media, reflecting ethnic achievements and power aside from mainstream American Media.

His modest motto is: To succeed, one must engage in hard work. Hard work and hard work! Result is not attributed to any individual's effort, but to "team work" by all the people working together, and more realistically, to moral support from family and friends.

A point worthy of recognition is that Vien thao Media has collaborated with other community entities in organizing big fund-raising events assembling hundreds of performers, scores of thousands of attendants, typically those events aimed at supporting flood victims in Central and Southwestern Vietnam. Another memorable event was the Vigil in the memory and honor of the 9/11 victims. Local television stations subsequently aired their touching reports about this event showing great crowd of about 20,000 Vietnamese holding American flags and candles, and singing God Bless America. Such event promoted the understanding, sympathy and cooperation between the Vietnamese community and others.

In promoting humanitarian spirit, Vien thao Media founded in 2004 THE VIETNAMESE ASSOCIATION FOR THE BLIND – USA (VAFTB – USA) scraping vision to 350.000 poor cataract patients in Việt Nam. Up to the end of 2005, VAFTB – USA had funded 18,000 cataract operations in 18 Vietnamese metropolitan areas and provinces. This program is projected to successfully complete its objectives in 5 years. It's a compassionate endeavor, touching almost everyone domestically and overseas.

Early 2005, Vien that Media organizes a vigil for the Tsunami victims. Despite the cold and stormy weather, thousands and thousands of people attended the event, leading to impressive fund-raising results that amazed San Jose' Police Chief Robert Davis, American Red Cross Representatives and elected officials through the outpouring of good will and humanitarian spirit from Vietnamese community.

In recent years, Vien Thao Media added to its diversified array of services that of travel. "V-Travel" – with its "Hội Ngộ Trùng Dương Cruises" fully and exclusively booking a complete luxurious cruise liner to cater to 3,000 Vietnamese in a pleasurable oceanic journey. Besides, V-Travel has offered an array of tours to China, Asia, Europe and many other parts of the world ranging from groups of dozens to those of hundreds tourists embarking on different itineraries, exploring new destinations, admiring new landscapes, tasting new foods, acquainting new cultures, adapting to new environments, bringing homes new souvenirs and memories according to each individual's choosing and / or liking, all sharing an utmost satisfaction, many committing to return for other V-Travel quality trips.

26-year span entails many things worthy of mention, especially worthy of expression of gratitude to all people, all contributions that may have seemed substantial or not, but have always been greatly treasured by Vien Thao Media.




